Three men injured in car accident while eluding police

On Monday, May 4 at 3:40 a.m. Lake Stevens Police Officers were on patrol and noticed that a sign blocking the entry to a local construction site had been pushed aside.

As officers entered the site to investigate, a Mazda truck was seen leaving the area at a high rate of speed.

The officers followed the truck which reached speeds of 70 miles per hour.

The Mazda turned off its headlights in an attempt to elude police officers.

At the 2800 block of Sunnyside Blvd, the Mazda failed to negotiate the turn and struck a retaining wall.

Three brothers were contacted and Aid was called to the scene.

A 21-year-old suspect was flown by helicopter to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle. The other two suspects, 19 and 21, were taken to Providence Regional Medical Center in Everett.

All three are expected to recover from their injuries. The driver will face charges of Felony Eluding and Vehicular Assault.
