Home Fire Sprinkler Facts

- Home fire sprinklers can contain and may even extinguish a fire before the fire department arrives on scene.
- Only the fire sprinkler closest to the fire will activate (not all of the sprinklers).
- Home fire sprinklers use only a fraction of the water the fire department would use to extinguish a fire. Fire sprinklers equal approximately 25 gallons of water per minute, whereas fire hose equals approximately 250 gallons of water per minute.
- Modern residential fire sprinklers can be inconspicuous, mounted and covered flush with the ceiling.
- Home fire sprinklers are as reliable as a plumbing system and run off the same water source as your home plumbing.

Q: What if my home doesn't have fire sprinklers and I can't afford to retrofit my home with fire sprinklers?

A: Maintaining properly working smoke alarms (testing them once a month, cleaning and replacing batteries every six months) will greatly increase the safety of your family. If you don't have smoke alarms in your home, please contact us about getting some installed. Smoke alarms help to save lives too!
