September 11, 2001, New York City

American Airlines #11 struck the north tower at 8:46 AM Eastern Time.  
United Airlines #175 struck the south tower at 9:03 AM Eastern Time.



The Pentagon, located across the Potomac River from Washington, D.C., was struck by American Airlines #77 at 9:37 AM Eastern Time.



United Airlines #93 crashed into a rural area near Shanksville, Pennsylvania, at 10:03 AM Eastern Time.  
"Let's Roll" -- Passengers worked together to prevent further damage by overtaking the hijackers and forcing the plane down, knowingly sacrificing their own lives.
